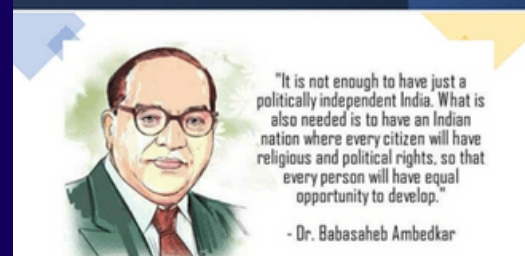
Every Republic day and Independence day to show respect to the acts of bravery and sacrifice of officers, civilians and soldiers.

Vikram Batra was an officer of the Indian Army. He was awarded the Gallantry Award. He won this award because of his actions of bravery and valor during the 1999 Kargil War, during which he led one of the most difficult mountain warfare operations in Indian history. He exposed himself to enemy fire to help an injured soldier get to safety, the enemy sniper and a splinter from an RPG hit him in the head and in the chest. Because of his fatal wounds he did not make it.

Vikram Batra helped an injured soldier while he was in pain motivates me to help humanity by bettering the lives around me. Becoming a doctor so I can help the injured soldiers.

In the village of Khajuri, near Shahjohannpur, Uttar Pradesh, Jadunath Singh Rathore was born on 21 November 1916 to a Rathore Rajput family. He was the son of Birbal Singh Rathore and Jamuna Kanwar. He has six brothers and sisters, he was third of eight children. The Param Vir Chakra India's highest military decoration, was Awarded to Jadunath Singh Rathore for his heroic actions during the Indo-Pakistani war of 1947. I am inspired to do something by Jadunath Singh. I imagine how he survived the war. I always think of what I can do to help my country. The conflict between India and Pakistan are more generally between Hindus and Muslims. The main reason there is a war because of the religion. Rich and Poor people fight, and that leads to war, so I plan to give 10 rupees to every homeless man I see.

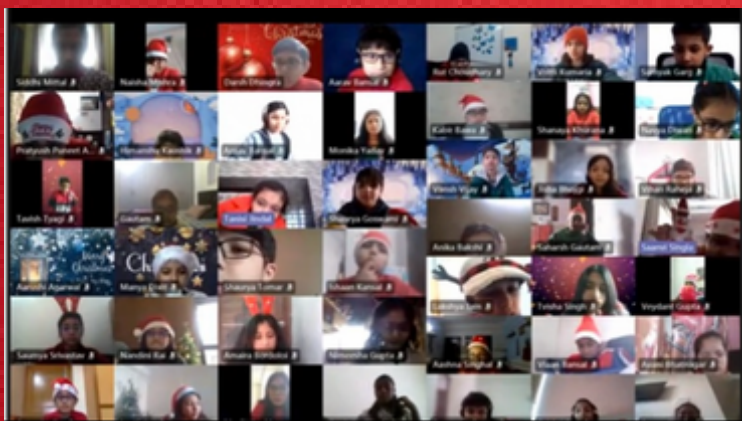
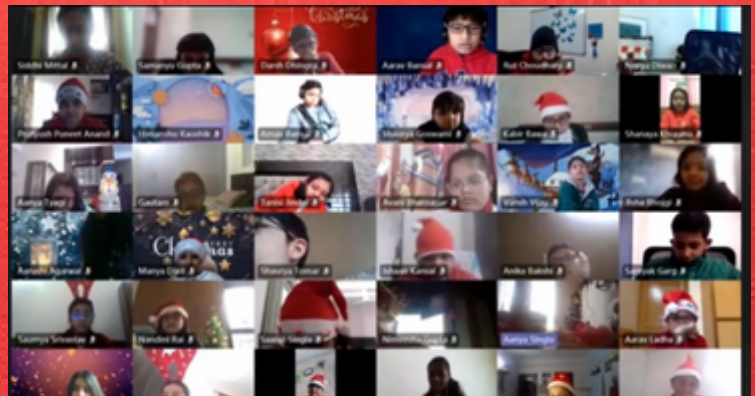
Christmas: A Harbinger of Happiness and Joy

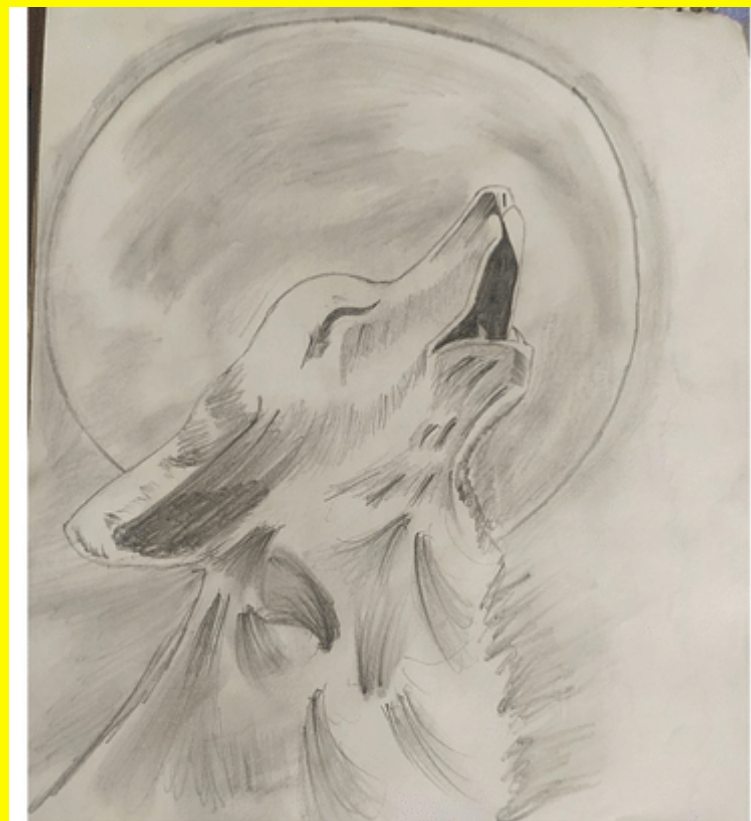
